A mail art exchange between a group of young people from Edinburgh Young Carers, artist Khadea Kuchenmeister and Collective.

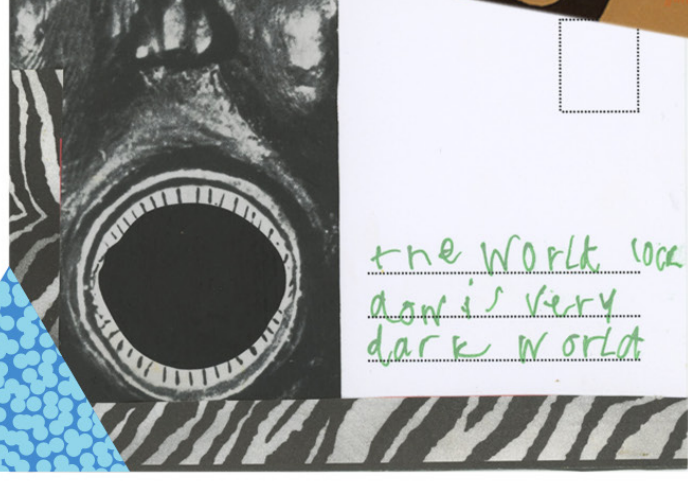

Can you draw it?



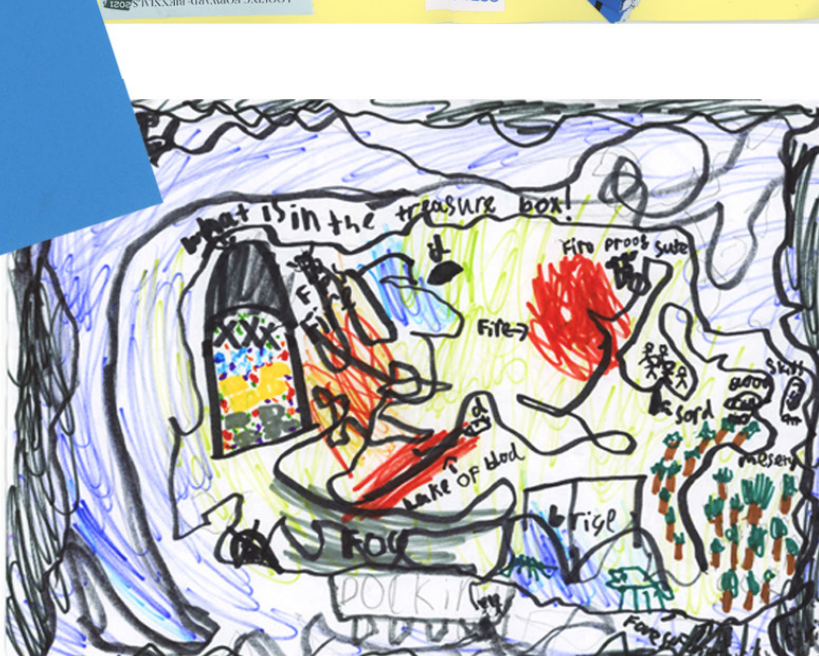
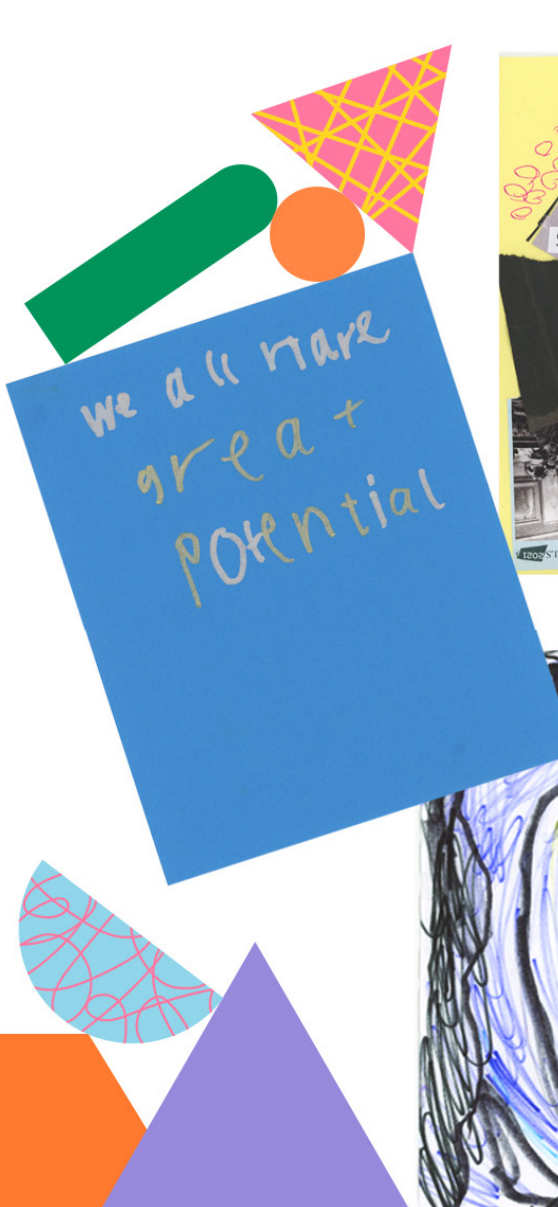
Prompt 3

Prompt 4

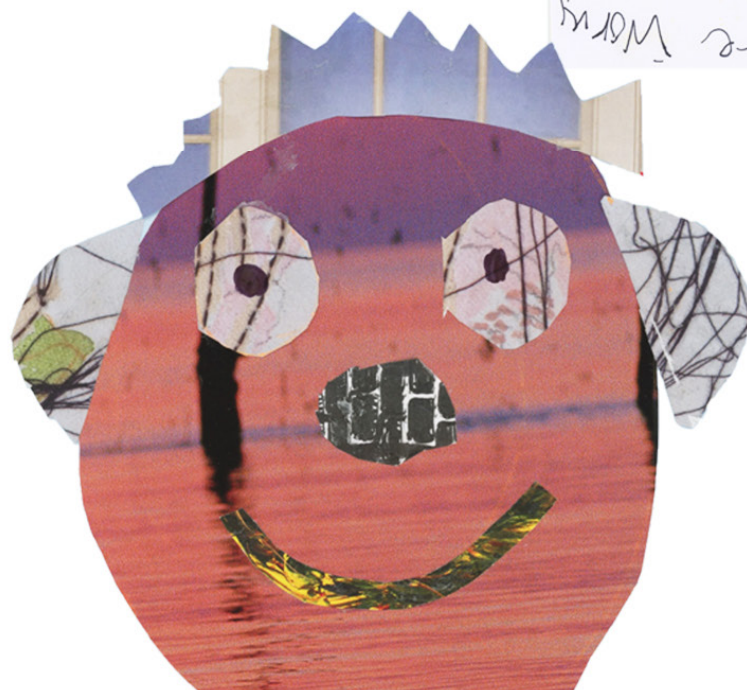
How do you see your creativity?



Prompt 5

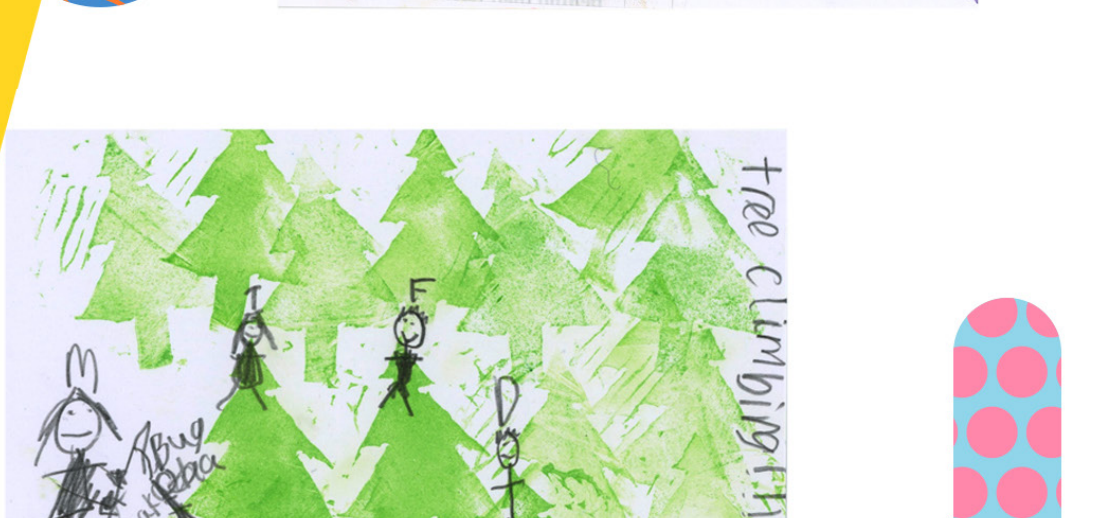
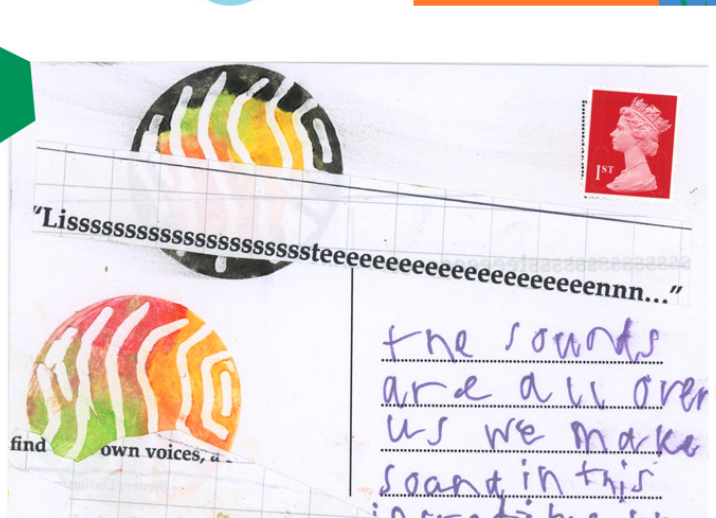
What would a celebration of your creativity look like?
